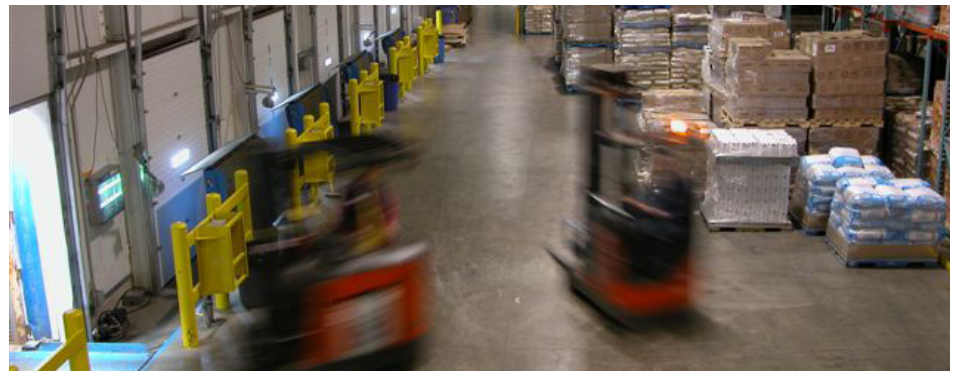
Mission Statement

Cold Chain Solutions

TCS works closely with multinational foodservice and retail manufacturers throughout North America to develop efficient temperature-controlled supply chain solutions, integrating TCS technology; ambient, refrigerated and frozen facilities, and comprehensive transportation services.

Special Projects

TCS pursues partnerships with companies seeking co-packing and/or food manufacturing partners, bringing economy of scale with our warehousing and distribution services. Our experience includes vegetable processing and co-packing, juice production, frozen food kit assembly, as well as build-to-suit dedicated facilities for major CPG (Consumer Product Goods) companies.

LTL Consolidation/Distribution Services

In support of manufacturers, foodservice and wholesalers, TCS operates the largest LTL Consolidation Program in Canada, handling more than 600 tractor-trailer loads of product every week with shipments across Canada, and with exports into the United States. Our hub in Trenton services temperature controlled freight movement across the country, from Newfoundland to British Columbia, and south into the United States, providing you with a "one stop shop" distribution solution.

Technology

Our facilities utilize the latest radio frequency technology, coupled with our web accessible warehouse management system and EDI technology which ensure the most efficient processes for our clients. All products are labelled according to client requirements and are tracked from receipt to shipment with emphasis on traceability and strict product recall requirements. All transactions are logged, time stamped and traceable to the TCS operator. EDI transactions include ASN, shipments, receipts, inventory adjustments and more. Data can be transferred using AS2, FTP, and email. Web based access to our system provides a wealth of information all at the finger tips of the user.

Import/Export Capabilities

TCS Cold Logistics provide services to support global supply chain requirements, including export stamping and documentation, import meat re-inspection, seafood inspection, container loading and unloading. Our facilities are HACCP recognized, CFIA approved, FDA registered, and subscribe to annual AIB audits.
